

BY-LAWS OF NAVARRE WOLVES GIRLS BASKETBALL

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of the organization shall be Navarre Wolves Girls Basketball (the “Organization”).

ARTICLE II – STATUS AND PURPOSE

The Organization is organized as a nonprofit, unincorporated association and shall operate exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The purpose of the Organization is to provide youth athletes with opportunities for competitive basketball participation, character development, leadership, teamwork, discipline, and sportsmanship, while promoting academic responsibility and community engagement.

ARTICLE III – PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of the Organization shall be located in Navarre, Florida, or such other location as determined by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IV – BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs of the Organization shall be governed by a Board of Directors. The Board shall consist of no fewer than three (3) directors and shall have full authority over policies, programs, and financial affairs. The Board shall meet at least annually. A majority of directors shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE V – OFFICERS

The officers of the Organization shall include a President / Head Coach, Vice President / Team Administrator, and Treasurer. The President / Head Coach provides leadership and oversees basketball operations. The Vice President / Team Administrator manages records and administrative functions. The Treasurer oversees financial records, banking, and reporting.

ARTICLE VI – FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION

The fiscal year shall be January 1 through December 31. All funds shall be deposited in accounts held in the name of the Organization. No single individual shall have sole control of funds. A minimum of two authorized signers shall be required. No part of the net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE VII – CONFLICT OF INTEREST

The Organization shall maintain a Conflict of Interest Policy requiring annual disclosure by all officers and directors.

ARTICLE VIII – MEMBERSHIP

The Organization shall not have members as defined under Florida law.

ARTICLE IX – DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution, assets shall be distributed exclusively for charitable purposes to one or more organizations qualifying under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE X – AMENDMENTS

These By-Laws may be amended by a majority vote of the Board of Directors at any duly called meeting.
